Back in 2022, St. Bartholomew had an unprecedented number of students thanks to our stable learning environment during the COVID years. While it was fun to have over 200 K-5 students in our building, we are back in a growth phase with 50 K-5 students and 45 Preschool students. This means smaller classes, more inter-grade socialization, group specials, and most importantly - a more tailored educational experience for your child with more one-on-one instructional time with teachers. While this presents some challenges, there are an even larger number of benefits! As one parent recently put it at our summer picnic - "It is like the best of both worlds - traditional school and a home school co-op!". We will *not* be combining class sizes or limiting your child's educational experience! We will be doing the opposite with the addition of Spanish and STEAM.

Small class sizes are often considered a significant factor in a student's educational experience. **Benefits of a Small Class Size**

- Individualized Attention: With fewer students, teachers can provide more one-on-one time guidance, and tailored feedback to each student. This allows them to better understand individual learning styles, strengths, and weaknesses.
- Enhanced Engagement and Participation: In a smaller, more intimate setting, students are more likely to feel comfortable asking questions, participating in discussions, and engaging in handson activities. This active involvement can lead to a deeper understanding of the subject matter.
- Stronger Student-Teacher Relationships: A smaller class size allows teachers to build stronger relationships with their students, fostering a supportive and trusting environment. This can improve student morale, accountability, and academic performance.
- Improved Academic Outcomes: Research, particularly from studies like the Tennessee STAR Project, has shown that students in smaller classes often have higher test scores and improved academic performance. The benefits are particularly pronounced for younger children and for students from disadvantaged backgrounds.
- Better Classroom Management: Fewer students generally mean fewer distractions and discipline problems, allowing teachers to spend more time on instruction and less on managing behavior.

Drop-in days are available on a limited basis to families who only need occasional after school care (a minimum of 24 hours notice is requested). Space is limited. We have done our best to keep our fees low and manageable, whether you have four kids or one at St. Bartholomew.

- Clubhouse contracts will be charged to TADS in October. There is an option to spread payments over several invoices. We will work with you!
- \$40 late pick-up fee will be assessed for students picked up after 5:35 pm.
- Drop-in rate for last minute care (i.e. late pick-up from carline) is \$30/day.
- Repeated late pick-ups from carline will result in a meeting with parents to plan for timely pick-up.
- Schedule changes require 2 weeks notice. Changes without notice will result in a \$40 fee.


